

Moving from Showmaster LE/Pro with Editor to Showmaster LE/Pro with Manager

User Checklist and FAQs



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Showmaster LE/Pro Upgrade to Manager

Showmaster LE and Pro units have previously used Showmaster Editor software. They now run Medialon Manager 7, in line with Showmaster Go and Mini. Any Showmaster can now be addressed as a full Windows PC using remote access (VNC or Remote Desktop Connection). Showmaster LE and Pro can also be addressed using the Manager Web Interface. Showmaster Mini and Go have direct USB and monitor connections.

How can I upgrade a Showmaster LE or Pro?

Existing Showmaster LE and Pro units may be upgraded from Showmaster V2, requiring return to 7thSense for replacement larger SSD and OS update, and installation of Manager 7.1.

Do I need to update my Showmaster Go or Mini?

Showmaster Go and Mini can be upgraded by the user to a later version of Manager, provided their version has a compatible major version licence. For example, a Mini with V7.0 will work alongside an upgraded Pro with 7.1.

How do I connect to an upgraded Showmaster LE or Pro?

Any Showmaster can be addressed using remote access software, including VNC or Windows Remote Desktop Connection (RDC) from another PC.

VNC is a popular cross-platform remote desktop system based on the Remote Frame Buffer Protocol. Since this is an open protocol, it is supported on multiple operating systems and embedded devices, and there are numerous free and commercial client viewers available.

For Windows RDC, just type 'RDC' into Windows search, and select the app.

TeamViewer Host is installed on Showmaster units so is available to users of TeamViewer Client.

Showmaster LE and Pro can also be addressed using the **Manager Web Interface**. It provides a simple way to configure and manage a Showmaster from any device with network access. It replaces much of the functionality previously provided by Showmaster Editor but in a less intrusive way. By default, the web interface is available on port 9258 and can be reached by entering the following URL in a browser: http://{ip address or network name of Showmaster}:9258

How do I put projects onto a Showmaster LE or Pro?

With Showmaster Editor, project files could be sent or retrieved to Showmaster Pro or LE units, to load an updated copy, or pull a copy from the hardware. Using the new web interface, hosted on the Showmaster hardware, you can download any of the project files stored on the Showmaster, or send a new project file to the Showmaster, and configure which project file should be loaded when the Showmaster boots.

Note: this method only applies to Showmaster Pro and LE, not Showmaster Go or Mini. File transfer using remote access is available to all models.

What do I need to do to make my Editor projects work in Manager 7?

Please note that projects created in Editor (from version 2.7) must be manually updated before being loaded in Manager 7.1. This is important to avoid corrupting projects written in older versions of Manager.

• Upgrading from a Showmaster project to a Showmaster running Medialon Manager V7.1

A 2-minute instruction on opening a Showmaster Project on a PC updated to Manager 7.1, changing its Target, and saving it for the new version of Manager.

• **Converting** Showmaster Projects to Medialon Manager V7.1 (to run on a different PC)

A 7-minute online step-through. If moving Showmaster projects created in V6 on a different PC, this requires Showmaster-specific physical devices (DMX, MIDI, Serial), input and output switches, and timecode IO to first be unassigned in Showmaster Editor. The project can then be loaded in Manager V7, switching the Target from Showmaster Pro to Manager Pro, then reassigning the resources.

How do I debug and test my projects?

Previously with Showmaster Pro and LE, this was done by using the Showmaster Editor software, remotely connected to the Showmaster unit. Where full Manager V7 is installed, Manager can be addressed directly on the Showmaster using remote access (VNC, RDC or TeamViewer), as described above and in the Remote Access guide.
